RECIPE OF THE WEEK

Taco Salad for a Large Crowd



Ingredients:

- 1-1/2 pounds ground beef
- 2 envelopes taco seasoning, divided
- 1 medium head iceberg lettuce
- 1 package tortilla chips, coarsely crushed
- 2 pints grape tomatoes, halved
- 2 cans kidney beans, rinsed and drained
- 1/2 oz. sliced ripe olives, drained
- 1-1/2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 large sweet onion, chopped
- 4 oz. chopped green chiles
- 1-1/2 cups Thousand Island salad dressing
- 1-1/3 cups salsa
- 1/3 cup sugar

Directions:

1. In a Dutch oven over medium heat, cook and crumble beef with 1 envelope plus 2 tablespoons taco seasoning, until meat is no longer pink; drain.
2. In a very large serving bowl, combine the lettuce, chips, tomatoes, beans, olives, cheese, onion, chiles and beef mixture.
3. In a small bowl, combine the salad dressing, salsa, sugar and remaining taco seasoning; pour over salad and toss to coat.


